You need better security, and Lockstraps locking tie-downs are the perfect solution.

Lockstraps have features which make your average tie-down seem more akin to cheap rope than a way to secure your motorcycle. These tie-downs come equipped with two very strong combination locking carabiners, eliminating the need for keys and allowing both ends of the straps to be secured in place without any chance of them coming loose. This also provides a theft-proof way to store the tie-downs in the bed of your truck or on your trailer without worrying that they will walk away with someone else. An exclusive component of Lockstraps is the steel cable which runs the entire length of the straps; no other tie-down has this feature. Built-in soft tie extensions keep your ride from being damaged in transport, and very beefy rivets are used throughout giving them industrial-strength durability.

Keeping your equipment secure and out of the hands of thieves is important to anyone who regularly carries their bikes or ATVs – or competes in club or national racing, or transports a machine for restoration, or any number of other uses. Lockstraps locking tie-downs are one of the best ways to do those things in a secure fashion. Their construction is rugged; the locks are case-hardened and do not require keys, and the internal steel cables keep them from being cut.

The verdict of a real-world test, you say? After many months of use they show no wear, look just as good as when they were first pulled from their package, and they have given no difference in application from any other standard strap.
