Member Review The first and only combo locking tie down strap! **Lockstraps**

Lockstraps are high a quality [tie](#) down strap with built in soft ties that also include beefy, combination locking carabiners on both ends as well as a full length steel cable embedded inside each strap.

Purely as a tie down strap, they work quite well, very much in line with any other quality strap on the market. The unique aspect of the product is the additional layer of security they provide in terms of theft. Just to be clear, the reality is, if someone wants your bike badly enough, they are most likely going to get it. So, these straps aren't designed to be the end all, be all of [security](#). What they are designed to do is to make it just that much harder to walk off with your bike. Criminals prefer easy hits, so the use of Lockstraps in conjunction with other [common sense measures](#) may be just enough to cause a criminal to look for an easier target.

You can use a single Lockstrap, but if you run two, knot the buckles when you tie down as well as locking the loose ends of the straps in the top locking carabiners, this does double the effort for thieves to defeat them and again, increasing the level of difficulty is the name of the game.

The bottom-line is that pretty much all of us use some sort of tie down strap, the Lockstraps perform this duty well, but do so with an extra measure of security that provides a little more peace of mind that our skoot will still be there when we get back from whatever it is we're doing. At least for me, this easily justifies the additional cost when compared to traditional straps.
